NGO Tontorino implemented a EU project "Experimental learning designers" in Samobor, Croatia from 5th till 11th of January 2016. The project is supported from the Agency for mobility and programmes within Erasmus+ program. This is Tontorino's second project financed from the forementioned Agency. The goals of the project are:

- To increase the competencies of 26 youth workers, trainers, youth leaders from 7 countries, in designing and delivering new activities based on the experiential learning model;
- To enforce the synergies between formal and non-formal education by creating a toolkit with tested experiential tools, available for free for youth workers;
- To capitalise the power of experiential learning for organisational development of the parties involved.
- To prepare quality non-formal project based on experimental learning among EU and EECA countries, matching the new requirements of Erasmus+ program with their organization;
- To offer the opportunity of meeting possible partner groups among EU and EECA countries.

Seven countries are involved in the project: Croatia, FYRO Macedonia, Italy, Lithuania, Romania, Turkey and Poland with 26 participants in total.
